RATE SCHEDULE 6
LARGE COMMERCIAL SERVICE
51 TO 1,000 KW Demand

AVAILABILITY

Available for commercial, industrial, master-metered trailer courts, and three-phase service for all uses including lighting, heating and power having an established measured demand over a 15 minute interval between 51 and 1,000 KW. Subject to the established rules and regulations of the Cooperative.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Single-phase, and three-phase at available secondary voltages. Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower must be three-phase with starting equipment approved by the Cooperative.

MONTHLY RATE

The sum of the following demand and energy charges

Service Availability Charge:

\$225.00 for the first 50 kW of demand or less.

Energy Charge:

5.55 cents/kWh

Demand Charge:

\$3.15 per kW for each kW of demand in excess of 50 kW.

POWER COST ADJUSTMENT

The monthly rate is subject to increases or decreases in the Cooperative's cost of wholesale purchased power.

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND

The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the consumer for any period of fifteen consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter and adjusted for power factor as follows:

POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT

The member agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Demand charges will be adjusted for average power factors lower than 95% and may be so adjusted for other consumers if and when the seller deems necessary. Such adjustments will be made by increasing the measured demand 1% by which the average power factor is less than 95% lagging.

Rate Schedule 6 Continued

TEMPORARY SERVICE

Temporary service shall be supplied in accordance with the foregoing rate except that the consumer shall pay, in addition to the foregoing charges, the total cost of connecting and disconnecting service, less the value of materials returned to stock. A deposit in advance shall be required for the full amount of the estimated bill for service including the cost of connection and disconnection.

SERVICE AT PRIMARY VOLTAGE

If service is furnished at primary voltage, a discount of \$.10 per kilowatt of demand per month. However, service may be metered at secondary voltage and adjusted to primary metering by adding the estimated transformer losses to the metered data.

DETERMINATION OF RATE SCHEDULE

Each commercial account will be reviewed on an annual basis, or as deemed necessary, to determine which rate schedule is appropriate based on the previous 12 month billing history. To be placed into the Large Commercial Rate Schedule 6, the billing history must exceed 50 KW during 4 of the 12 previous months.
