SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Member is responsible for financing, installing and ownership of standards, luminaries and the necessary circuitry to connect with KEC designated points of delivery. All such facilities will conform to KEC design, standards and specifications. Member is also responsible for painting (if desired) and replacing damaged light poles **and luminaries**.

KEC will furnish the necessary energy, repairs and maintenance work, including lamp replacement and glassware cleaning. Maintenance and replacement of lamps, cleaning of fixture glass and general scheduled maintenance will be performed by KEC at 60 month intervals. Repairs and maintenance work will be performed by KEC during regularly scheduled working hours.

Faulty individual lamps will be replaced as soon as reasonably possible after notification by Member and subject to KEC's operating schedules and requirements.

KEC will make any change in location at the request and expense of the member.
